

## **UTPA Concurrent Enrollment Program Information Page**

<b>Fligibility</b>	Requirements	for New	<b>Applicants</b>

Be classified as a high school junior or senior on target towards graduating under the Recommended of
Distinguished High School Graduation Program.

- Submit official verification of having met the criteria for one of the programs below:
  - o At least one of the following criteria must be met:
    - Rank in the top 10% of your graduating class
    - Have a 90 GPA or higher (on 100-pt scale)
    - Have a minimum composite score on ACT of 22 OR SAT of 1030 (using only CR+M)
  - Under the Independent Student Program, applicants must have a minimum ACT composite of 22 or SAT combined Math and Verbal/Critical Reading score of 1030 in addition to either of the following:
    - Rank in the top 10% of your graduating class (rank and class size will be used to determine)
    - Have a 90 GPA or higher

## **Application Process Requirements**

- ☐ The application is available via the internet at <a href="www.applytexas.org">www.applytexas.org</a>.
  - Apply as a US Entering Freshman
  - Request for your application to be submitted to UTPA
  - Indicate interest in participating by answering YES to question at end of application: "are you currently a high school student planning to take college courses at UTPA prior to high school graduation?"
- ☐ Submit a completed CE Authorization form.
  - o The Apply Texas application must be submitted <u>prior</u> to submitting the CE Authorization Form.
  - o CE Authorization Forms are available through the high school counselor
  - o Must be read and signed by Parent, Counselor, and Principal/Assistant Principal
- ☐ Submit High School Transcript.
  - Transcript must include class ranking, and GPA (on a 100-point scale)
  - Must also include graduation date and type of graduation plan (recommended or distinguished)
- ☐ Submit any test scores to determine TSI status (THEA, ACCUPLACER, TAKS, ACT, SAT).
- ☐ Submit proof of Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination (must be current 10 days prior to 1<sup>st</sup> day of class)

## TSI and Placement Requirements

The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) law requires all entering college students to be assessed for college readiness in reading, writing, and math, unless the student qualifies for an exemption.

- ☐ Students can be exempt from TSI based on scores from one of the following exams (must meet all three scores in one exam; no "mixing")
  - Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (11<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> grade only)
    - 2200 Math (UTPA Math Department does not use TAKS-Math; student will be restricted)
    - 2200 English/Language Arts with
    - a 3 on the Writing section
  - **ACT or ACT Residual** 
    - Composite of 23 with 19 English and 19 Math or higher
  - SAT
    - Composite of 1070 (Critical Reading plus Math) with 500 Critical Reading and 500 Math
- ☐ If not exempt, the student must take a TSI exam and receive a passing score (below):
  - o THEA/Q-THEA:

- Writing- 220 (TSI passing scores)

- (UTPA required)

- ACCUPLACER:
- Reading- 78
- Math-63 (EA)
- Writing- 80/5 OR essay of 6+ (TSI passing)

- o ACCUPACER:

- M- 70 (CLM)
- W- 80/5 OR essay of 6+ (UTPA required)
- o PLAN or PSAT: same as ACT/SAT; only accepted when there is no other exam available.
- Submit records of other college level course work completed by submitting score report or college transcript (AP credits, CLEP, Dual Enrollment courses) prior to Advisement & Registration.
