

Credit By Exam Review English III Part B

The exam will have 80 multiple choice questions (1 point each) and an essay question (20 points). Thirty-three (53) questions will be about the reading selections, 17 will cover the research process (Unit 7) and 10 will be revising and editing.

You will have three essay topics to choose from. The essay topics will be about the selections from the textbook and the outside novel you need to read.
