

COLLEGE DAY PASS

A senior/junior is allowed two college days their senior/junior year. These college days are excused absences that will not count against exemptions.

The criteria are as follows:

- If a senior/junior is visiting a college under 300 miles away, he/she qualifies for one college day.
- If a senior/junior is visiting a college over 300 miles away, he/she qualifies for two college days.
- The student must bring proof of attendance from the college.
- Only seniors and juniors qualify for college days.
- The request for a college day must be PRE-APPROVED AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE.
